## Eco Pass Master Contract Guidelines

Master Contract agents may select from three participation options. The minimum Master contract amount per agent is \$10,000 per year. Employers and employees may not be charged for the passes.

### Option 1 CAGID

- A. All companies within a defined contiguous contract boundary would be eligible and paid for.
- B. A large employer discount would be given based on the total number of eligible employees at the time the contract is signed.
- C. No individual employer minimum contracts would be required.
- D. The agent would be required to provide RTD with a list of all employers and number of employees at least 30 days prior to contract signing. The list would be subject to audit verification prior to contracting with RTD.

### Option 2

- A. All companies within the defined boundary would not have to participate in the program.
- B. A large employer discount would apply for companies not covered by contract minimum amounts.
- C. Individual contract minimums would be charged for participating small employers within a defined boundary. Minimum contract amounts will not be prorated.

### Option 3 US 36 wants to do this one

- A. All companies within the defined boundary would not have to participate in the program.
- B. A large employer discount would not apply.
- C. The regular per employee rate would be charged based on individual company size.
- D. No individual employer minimum contracts would be required.

## Your options

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Choose to have your employees pay for their FlexPasses, or explore our discount programs.

1. **Matching discount:**  
If your business decides to subsidize a portion of FlexPass, RTD will match that amount up to 10%, with the savings passed on to the employee.
2. **Pre-tax discount:**  
If your business offers FlexPass on a pre-tax basis, RTD will provide a 5% discount on every pass.
3. **Quantity discount:**  
If your business purchases at least 200 passes per month on average, RTD will provide a 5% discount on every pass.

- Passes are mailed to employee or business prior to the month of usage.
